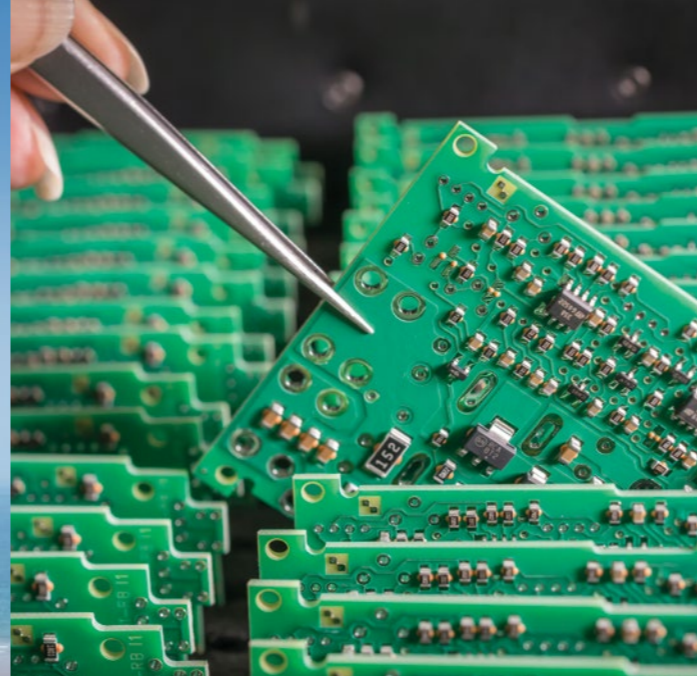

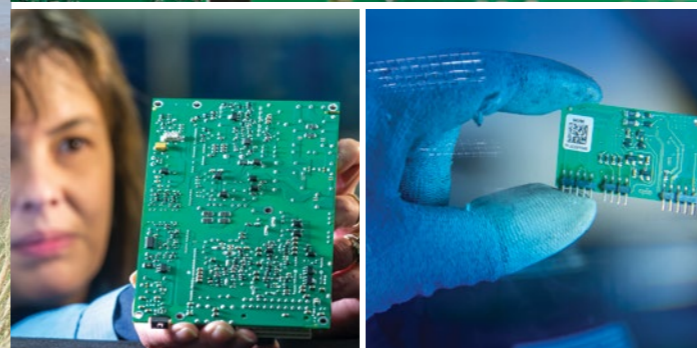


## MY CAREER IN NORTH DEVON
